

TRANSPORTATION

There are two airports that fly into the Bay Area and provide access to public transportation to the Hotel Shattuck: San Francisco International Airport (SFO) and Oakland International Airport (OAK). We recommend taking BART (Bay Area Rapid Transit) from either airport to the Downtown Berkeley station, which is one block from the Hotel Shattuck Plaza.

Flying into SFO (for maps, etc. go to www.flysfo.com)

If you land in the International Terminal, you are steps away from BART. If you land in Terminals 1-3, take the AirTrain (free) to BART – signs will guide you. You will need to purchase a BART ticket from a machine – it will take both cash and credit cards. Right now, the cost for a one-way ticket from SFO to Downtown Berkeley is \$8.65 and takes about 53 minutes. You will take the BART heading towards Pittsburgh/Bay Point through San Francisco. About 44 minutes into your ride, you will transfer at the 19th Street stop in Oakland. You will cross the platform where a train will be waiting (or arrives within the minute) – this train will be heading toward the EAST BAY (signs above will tell you this). Your ride from 19th Street Oakland to Downtown Berkeley is 9 minutes. When you exit BART at the Downtown Berkeley stop, go up the escalator. Once off the escalator, turn left, walk one block to Allston Way, turn right on Allston Way, and the Hotel Shattuck Plaza will be on your left.

SFO has several museum exhibitions, as well plaques for several inductees to the Bay Area Hall of Fame. Their website has information on the upcoming exhibits.

Flying into Oakland (www.flyoakland.com)

Oakland is a much smaller airport with two terminals. When you exit the terminals, you will walk across to the AirBART stop outside between Terminals 1 and 2 at the third curbside. AirBART tickets currently cost \$3 and require exact change. AirBART will transport you to the Coliseum/Oakland Airport Station, where you will need to purchase a BART ticket. Currently the cost of a one-way ticket from the Coliseum/Oakland Airport Station to Downtown Berkeley is \$2.35 and takes 21 minutes. You will board a RICHMOND train (this will show up on the signs above, as well as signs directing you to the EAST BAY). This ride is a straight shot, no transfers. When you exit BART at the Downtown Berkeley stop, go up the escalator. Once off the escalator, turn left, walk one block to Allston Way, turn right on Allston Way, and the Hotel Shattuck Plaza will be on your left.

BART begins service around 5am during the week and 8am on weekends. BART runs until around midnight. For BART schedule planners, go to www.bart.gov

There are also other ways to get yourself from either airport, including Super Shuttle, BayPorter Express (their number is 1-415-467-1800; www.bayporter.com), and taxi. These options are more expensive.

Both airports offer rental cars. For info on parking at the Hotel Shattuck Plaza, contact the hotel directly at (510) 845-7300 or toll free (866) 466-9199.
