## **NASSH-Lake Placid Convention Policy for Publishing Company Representation/Exhibition**

The following parameters will apply to publishers/exhibitors at the 2008 Convention, held in Lake Placid, New York, May 23-26, 2008:

1. NASSH will provide each exhibitor one table to display books, separate and distinct from the usual NASSH Book Display, as well as the opportunity to place limited advertising material in each NASSH delegate's welcome package.
2. NASSH offers the opportunity for the publisher/exhibitor to sell books at the Convention.
3. Exhibition table materials are the sole responsibility of the publishing firm. Such tables may be supervised/monitored or unsupervised/unmonitored, according to wish, but neither NASSH nor the Hilton Lake Placid Resort will provide oversight or security for the environment. Though theft is not anticipated, we believe it necessary to clearly present arrangements proposed.

In exchange for the opportunity to display and sell goods, any interested publisher will be charged \$150 (U.S.). Any representative of a publishing company attending NASSH will be required to be a paid registrant (\$70 U.S. with respect to 2008 Convention in Lake Placid, New York). NASSH members will be offered a special room rate for this convention at the Hilton Lake Placid Resort. Representatives of any publisher shall be eligible for those same room rates which includes a meal package. If the representative stays at an alternative hotel, he/she will be required to pay the Hilton Lake Placid Resort a separate daily convention rate for meals, coffee breaks, and the closing banquet.
